


ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK AND ACTION TAKEN (SESSION 2023-24)

Students' Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The college collects the feedback on various aspects from the students using structured questionnaire. The feedback collected from the students has been analysed and action taken to strengthen the quality of teaching learning environment and to look for opportunities to improve overall performances including teacher in classroom engagement with students to bring excellence in teaching and learning. This questionnaire is intended to collect information relating to your satisfaction towards facilities and services provided for creating conducive atmosphere for teaching and learning. The information provided by the students was kept confidential and was used as important feedback for quality improvement of the various courses and programmes offered by college. In order to arrive at comprehensive results, statistical analysis and graphic representations has been undertaken. The responses are scored in a five-point scale for each item i.e., **Excellent, Very Good, Good, Average and Poor**. Student indicates his / her level of agreement with the following statements by selecting appropriate option.

- Total responses received for College Infrastructure Feedback were 321,
- Total responses received for Curriculum & Syllabus Feedback were 288,
- Total responses received for Faculty Performance Feedback were 285,
- Total responses received for Laboratory Feedback were 261, from students of various classes. The IQAC has analysed the responses of students' feedback form and report submitted to authorities, who in turn discuss at various fora, including meetings with the head of the departments, IQAC and Staff Members.

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### STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

The following points emerged from the analysis of students' feedback survey:

- 1. Most of the students are highly satisfied with the College Infrastructure facilities.
- 2. Most of the students are highly satisfied with the Curriculum & Syllabus.
- 3. Vast majority of the students are happy with the Faculty Performance in the college
- 4. Most of the students are happy with the Laboratory facilities available in the campus.
- 5. Vast majority of the students are happy with the Library Facilities available in the college
- 6. Some students have sought additional support to enhance the placement potential, by organising more workshops on soft skills, interview handling, preparing for competitive exams etc.
- 7. Students expressed satisfaction with the functioning of Grievances cell and Sexual harassment cell.
- 8. The students are happy with the buildings/classrooms which are accessible to differently bled persons.
- 9. Majority of the students agreed that overall atmosphere in the college campus is conductive.

- The feedback & suggestions obtained are discussed with the higher authorities and the issues of special concerns are addressed and discussed in the in-house meetings for the upcoming session. Required actions were taken in the form of sending circulars to departments.

## ACTION TAKEN

1. More sports programmes events were organized. The college provides incentives and support to the players

2. Books of latest editions are regularly purchased in libraries as per the course syllabus.

3. Projectors were installed in the classrooms to use different teaching aids which help students in better learning and understanding

4. Efforts have been made to improve the internet and Wi-Fi facilities in the campus.

5. Students are made aware of placement /outcome of the programme during Orientation/induction Programs in the beginning.

6. More of industrial visits and field visits are conducted now, also teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process. Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.

7. More career guidance and soft skill development schemes have been implemented.

8. Department of Alumni Relations has organised interactive sessions with prominent alumni on guidance and career counselling as well as motivational talks
